Re: Mr. Taro Nippon

To Whom It May Concern:

I saw Mr. Taro Nippon today at our pediatric clinic for an annual checkup. Taro was born on December 1, 1992 and has been well without significant medical problems except mild attacks of bronchial asthma, which sometimes require nebulizer treatment with bronchodilator. I expect this to subside with age and he is not currently on any routine medication. He has No Known Drug Allergies.

The following is the record of his immunization. Although his TB skin test was positive 8 months ago, he received a BCG vaccination before when he was 6 month old. Since the prevalence of tuberculosis is relatively high in Japan, we still use BCG as a routine vaccination for infants. Taro does not have signs or symptoms of tuberculosis at all. I believe the positive TB test result is the consequence of proper immunization.
